Two important property Tax Exemptions Forms for the 2008-2009 fiscal year are available for qualifying Veterans and Surviving Spouses at the Senior Center Information Table.

The Affidavit of Veteran's form requires Military service between particular dates. To apply for the exemption of \$2,260 in assessed value on your real property tax bill for July 1, 2009, you must complete and return the affidavit by June 15, 2009.

The affidavit must be notarized.

The affidavit of surviving spouse form allows an exemption of \$1,130 in assessed value on your real property tax bill for July 1, 2009. The form must be completed and returned to the Clark County Assessor's Office at 500 S. Grand Parkway, 2nd floor, in Las Vegas by June 15, 2009.




A copy of your spouse's Death Certificate must accompany the affidavit.

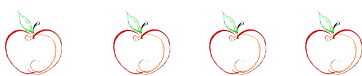
