Attention lets make sure you get the Tax Rebate

Congress gave its final approval on the Stimulus package. That means that every person that files federal income taxes will receive a Stimulus Package. If you file, or do not have to file, AARP Tax Aide, will provide free tax Help to people age 60 and older. A walk-in clinic will be held at the Senior Center on March 17th, from 8:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., for those who do not need to file. Bring in all income statements for 2007, such as, wages, Social Security, Disability, and retirement benefits. **YOU MUST HAVE A VALID SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER** . In most cases, the payment will equal the amount of tax liability on the tax return. With a maximum amount of \$600.00 for individuals return. The law also allows for payments for select taxpayers who have no tax liability. These taxpayers will be eligible to receive a payment of \$300.00 if they had at least \$3,000 of qualifying income. While these people may not be normally required to file a tax return because they do not meet the filing requirements, **the IRS emphasizes they must file 2007 return in order to receive payment.**

So remember March 17th, from 8:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. we will have a walk in clinic to help our seniors get in on the TAX REBATE CHECKS. Please note it's a walk in clinic. First come first served.
